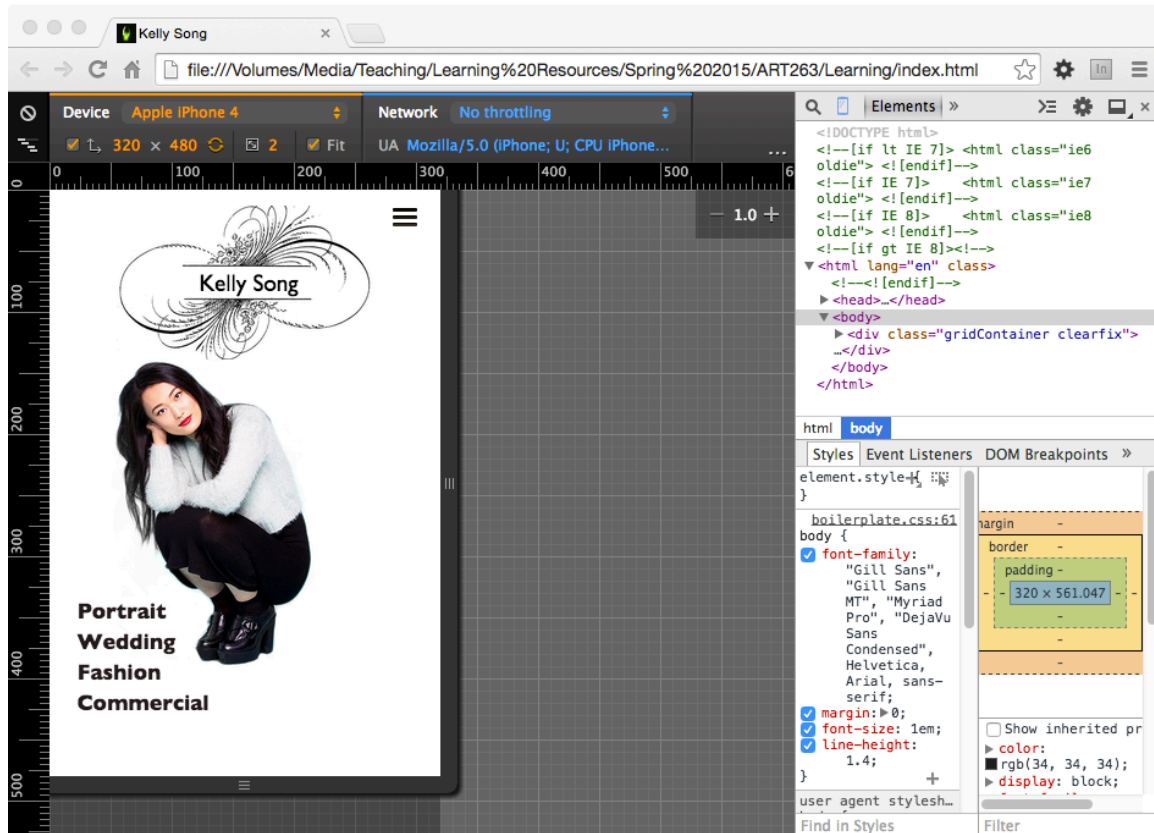


Emulating Your Web Site on Various Platforms using Chrome

Chrome provides substantial web site previewing features within its Developer Tools. To use these features follow the guide below.



1. Open the web page you wish to view.

2. In Google Chrome's Developer Tools you can now emulate web sites on different devices. To get to this feature, in Chrome go into the View menu and choose Developer -> Developer Tools. The tools palette will either open at the bottom of the browser window or to the right, depending on your settings. If you want to move it to the right (which I recommend) just click and hold on the docking icon to change the layout.



device mode

3. Next step is to go into *device mode*, which lets you emulate viewing your site in various devices. Click on the blue mobile device icon to toggle device mode.

4. In the *Device* tab select the device you wish to preview your site in.
5. Click on the browser refresh arrow to reload your page so it displays accurately.



swap dimensions

6. To switch the orientation of the device click on the *Swap Dimensions* arrows.
